

House Rules 7132 Therme

PURPOSE

1. The house rules ensure safety, order, and cleanliness in the entire facility and provide tranquility for all guests.
2. The house rules are binding for all visitors.
3. By entering the 7132 Therme, the guest declares his consent to the observance and compliance with the provisions of the house rules and all other orders issued to maintain operational safety.
4. The employees of the bath exercise the domiciliary right towards all guests. Please follow the instructions. Guests who violate the house rules can be expelled from the property.

OPERATING TIMES & ACCESS

1. You can find the currently valid prices and opening times on the notices and website.
2. Guests of the 7132 Hotel and 7132 House of Architects benefit from extended opening times.
3. External guests are very welcome with their children over six years of age.
4. At the end of the publicly announced bathing time, the bath, and facilities close for guests.
5. The guests must refrain from doing anything that does not follow good morals and maintain security, peace, and order. You must behave in such a way that no one else is harmed, endangered, or avoidably hindered or harassed. Guests should refrain from public displays of affection.
6. Re-entry is not permitted. Guests must pay the admission fee again.

PHOTO & FILM RECORDINGS

1. We want to guarantee privacy for all of our guests; it is strictly forbidden to take and use cell phones, smartphones, tablets, and all other devices with a camera function into the thermal baths.
The 7132 Therme is a place of relaxation - let the unique architecture and the soothing feeling of water and Vals quartzite amaze you! It works best without the distraction of electronic devices.
2. Commercial purposes and press visits, photography, and filming require the prior approval of the hotel management. Any legal costs in the event of a breach regarding the permit requirement will be invoiced.

BATHING GUESTS

1. All visitors are welcome to use the 7132 thermal baths. However, people with open wounds, fever, contagious diseases, or those under the influence of intoxicating substances must stay home.
2. If a guest poses a danger to others or himself due to alcohol consumption, our team will expel this guest from the facility.
3. Non-swimmers are only allowed to visit the thermal baths when accompanied by a supervisor.
4. Persons with health problems and mentally disabled persons are only allowed to enter and stay in the company of an authorized supervisor. The accompanying person takes full responsibility for the person to be supervised.
5. We advise guests with cardiovascular problems and pregnant women to ask their doctor about the appropriate bathing behavior and duration.

SWIMWEAR

1. Bathing at 7132 thermal baths is only permitted in regular swimwear. It should correspond to the generally applicable concepts of decency and morality and be color-fast. Wearing underwear under swim shorts is prohibited for reasons of hygiene.
2. It is not allowed to wash or wring out swimwear in the swimming pool.

USE OF THE BATH

1. Guests must treat the infrastructure with care. Any damage or contamination is prohibited and is obliged to pay compensation. In the event of contamination, a cleaning fee will be charged, which must be paid immediately at check-out. Any damage or soiling of the bathroom furnishings must be reported to employees immediately.
2. In the event of a thunderstorm, leave the outdoor facilities immediately.

BEHAVIOR IN THE THERME

1. Smoking inside the thermal baths or around the outdoor pool is not permitted.
2. Please do not enter barefoot areas in street shoes or street clothes.
3. Please refrain from using soap, brushes, and other cleaning agents outside of shower rooms. Shaving, cutting nails, brushing teeth, and coloring hair are prohibited at 7132 Therme.
4. It is forbidden to use glass containers (bottles, etc.) at 7132 Therme.
5. Jumping from the edge into the pool, running, gymnastics on access ladders and handrails, and throwing objects into the pool is strictly forbidden.
6. The use of fins, snorkels, underwater cameras, large water toys such as beach balls, pool noodles, large swimming boards, etc. is not permitted
7. Please do not reserve any loungers. Our employees have the instructions to vacate reserved spaces.
8. Bringing and consuming food and drinks in thermal baths is not permitted for hygiene reasons.
9. The thermal baths are a place of relaxation. For your well-being and that of the other guests, please remain quiet.

LIABILITY

1. Guests use the facilities at their own risk.
2. Parents and other accompanying persons subject to supervision are liable for the children and the persons supervised.
3. The guests are responsible for locking the lockers themselves.
4. The 7132 Therme is not liable for personal injury, property damage, or financial loss.
5. The 7132 Therme is not liable for the destruction, damage, or loss of items brought into the facility. This rule also applies to items deposited in the cloakroom lockers.

BUSINESS INTERRUPTIONS

1. The 7132 Therme reserves the right to restrict the use of the pool or parts of it.
2. In the event of business interruptions resulting from operational disruptions or other causes, the 7132 Therme will not provide any compensation.

LOST & FOUND

1. Found items must be handed over to the employees. The employees will handle the lost property following the statutory provisions.
2. Our employees will open cabinets that are still locked after closing time. Lost property will be handled following the statutory provisions.
3. Lost and found items are kept for one year and then donated to charitable organizations or disposed of. The process also applies to valuables. Any money found will be handed over to the Lost & Found department of the local police station.
4. Lost property and valuables are shipped at the explicit request of the owner. The owner pays for the shipping costs. In the event of loss or non-delivery of a shipment, liability will not be accepted.

EXCEPTIONS

1. The house rules apply to the general operations. Exceptions can occur for special events without the need to specifically revoke the house rules.
